Concept Note

RES4Africa is organizing a high-level Business-to-Government (B2G) workshop focused on **the long-term strategies for integrating renewable energy into the national electric system**, attracting investments and exploiting the socio-economic benefits of renewables in Ethiopia. Furthermore, the **results of the study "Integration of variable renewable energy into the national electric system"** - carried out by **RES4Africa** and **Enel Foundation**, thanks to the expertise of **CESI** consultant - will be presented.
